At Pendlewood Ltd we pledge to strive to the highest possible standards when dealing with the environment.

We will:

Always use timber from sustainable sources. Sustainable timber is guaranteed to have come from a well managed plantation.

Ensure our environmental and timber standards will at a minimum match those of the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC), UKWAS and the Pan European Forest Council. Indeed, where possible, we aim to have a higher level of responsible forestry.

Make sure that where possible the timber we will use will be locally produced, which we term as within a 20 mile radius from our workshop. This is because locally produced timber is truly sustainable and we are then able to strictly observe the re-forestation of our local plantations. Indeed our locally produced timber can be traced from the day of planting to the dignified end of its first life.

Guarantee that all treated timber is pressure treated Tanalith E. Tanalith E conforms to the efficacy requirements of BS EN 599-1:1997, and is treated in accordance with the penetration and retention guidance given in BS EN 351-1:1996 to give a desired service life in the selected hazard class as defined in BS EN 335-1:1992.

Ensure all timber is seasoned naturally and avoids placing any additional, unnecessary strain on the environment. This is achieved as we have developed our own planing and air-drying facilities for our timber.
